Touro has affiliation agreements with area hospitals and local physicians so students can complete their clinical work without having to leave the state. However, for students who seek opportunities for clerkships in other parts of the country, there are a number of rotation sites available.

The Touro University Nevada campus is the heart of your educational experience. Consistent with our unique approach to education, our campus is a collection of state-of-the-art lab spaces, lecture rooms, community focused clinics and administrative offices in a single expansive building.

The campus facility is open to all students from 6 a.m. until 2 a.m. That means nearly round-the-clock access and fellowship – enhanced by the peace of mind you get from on-site security 24 hours a day.
