- **Authors' Rights**
This workshop provides a brief overview of authors' rights in publishing scholarly works, including author agreements and copyright.

Google Scholar provides a simple way to broadly search for scholarly literature. We will discuss its strengths, as well as its shortcomings. We will set up a Google Scholar account and learn how to create citation alerts.

- **Altmetrics**

- **EndNote and APA Style Central**
This workshop will introduce the bibliographic manager, EndNote. Learn how to export article citations from databases, format citations automatically, and integrate your citations into MS Word. 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- **Scopus**
Scopus is one of the largest abstract and citation databases of peer-reviewed literature. We will look at how to search for abstracts, manage results, create alerts on research interests, and learn how to check if we have been cited in any articles.

- **Cabells Database and Predatory Journals**
Cabells helps researchers choose the best journal for their academic goals. It includes a white list of vetted journals as well as a black list of predatory journals that need to be avoided. We will cover how to use this database and get help in finding the most appropriate and safest journals for future publications.
