Quertle Qinsight is a research database and an artificial intelligence-based discovery tool for biomedical literature covering more than 40 million research articles, patents, and other information, including more than 10 million full-text documents. Predictive Visual Analytics enable deeper understanding and go beyond a simple listing of citations. Quertle Qinsight is a very useful addition to our growing selection of research tools, that includes EndNote, Google Scholar, PubMed@TUN, and Scopus.
